CHRISTMAS TREES TO THE STATE CAPITOL



Delivery of Christmas Trees to the Governor is an exciting experience. Franco & Sigrid Camacho had delivered the trees in 2012 and were willing to do it again in 2013 because they are so close and they enjoyed the experience. The Agriculture Department called and ask if a different family could deliver the trees each year. So, Michael & Linda Songer and Granddaughter Kacey, age 11, delivered the trees for 2013.

Tom Thomas, Dept of Agriculture, came to our farm on Wednesday December 4th and picked up a 7.5 foot Cedar, a 7.5 foot Spruce Pine, two 7 foot Leyland Cypress, and a 6.5 foot Sand Pine. The trees were taken to Tallahassee and set up in the Capitol Building.

On Monday December 9th we went to Tallahassee in the late afternoon and stayed in the Quality Inn so we could be at the Capitol at 8 am on Tuesday, December 10th.

At the Capitol we met Pam Bondi, Attorney General; Alan Putnam, Commissioner of Agriculture; and Jeff Atwater, CFO. We then went to meet with Governor Rick Scott and his wife Ann. The Governor's wife asked Kacey to place the official Florida ornament for 2013 on one of the trees. Then the Governor and Kacey pressed the button to officially light the tree. There were photographers and members of the press there to record the event, and Kacey was thrilled to later see herself on TV. Several years ago, I went with Mark Powell and his younger daughter to present trees to Governor Jeb Bush. Politicians like to have a child around for picture taking. So, when your turn comes be sure to take your Granddaughter or Grandson or another young child.

We were on the Government News station in Tallahassee, and the pictures were picked up by several other TV stations. We had some comments from customers that they had seen us on TV. You are representing your farm and the Florida Christmas Tree Association. Michael

Florida Christmas Tree Association Board of Directors And Business Meeting September 28- 29, 2013

The meeting was called to order at Bob and Joyce Neilson's Christmas tree farm at Trenton.

The Tremendous News newsletter is mailed out to members who do not use E-mail. It costs \$2.00 to print and \$1.00 to mail. Converts to E-mail would reduce costs and work!

There was an interest in what prices were for trees at the various locations. Some farms put their pricing on their web site. Pricing varied as shown below.

- 1) Under 6' = \$24.95 7' = \$27.95
- 2) \$6 per foot
- 3) 4' = \$16 The farm is considering a blanket \$35 per tree for all trees under 10'
- 4) 6' Carolina Sapphire (Arizona Cypress) \$48
- 5) 6' = \$25
- 6) \$5 and \$6 per foot up to 10': over 10' = \$8 per foot It was noted that prices are going up and some areas have better pricing power.

We are still having problems being allowed to put our signs up on public right of way land. For example, for \$200 paid to the DOT (Department of Transportation) one can put up a sign on the right of way. Mark Powell reported he could put up a generic directional sign such as "Christmas Tree Farm" for 2 months. It seems a lot depends on the county.

Mark Powell has volunteered to have the 2014 fall meeting at his Powell Christmas Tree Farm. Thank you Mark and Kay! He will try to find a date when Gainesville and Tallahassee do not have a football game and the Georgia Christmas Tree Association is not meeting. The Georgia meeting is once a year on a Saturday starting at 8:00am and ending at 4:30pm.

Jodi Utsman reported that FL Statute 570.964 had passed requiring a sign with specific size letters and wording to be posted at tree farms to avoid (reduce) liability claims. She brought many of them for us to purchase at her cost. Thank you JODI!

E-mail inquiries come to Michael Songer and John Gregory. They E-mail each other so both of them do not reply. Thank you Michael and John! The FCTA Tremendous News can be viewed on the website: www.flchristmastrees.com by clicking on "newsletters".

The Board of Directors met 9-29 at John and Cathie Gregory's Unicorn Hill Christmas Tree Farm. The consistent participation and support from Bill and Sara Murray led the Directors to vote and approve them to be Honorary members of FCT A. The Secretary is to write a congratulatory letter to them and the Treasurer is to have a certificate prepared.



Superior Nursery at Lee, Florida. Phone 850-971-5159 They have bare root Southern Red Cedar (\$214..per thousand). They have Spruce Pine, and Virginia Pine seedlings (\$87. per thousand.) available for the Fall Season. They are out of Sand Pine for this year.

Dwight Stansel Farm & Nursery, 5553 164th St, Wellborn, FL 32094, Phone 386-963-2827, e-mail [dsfntte@windstream.net] raises bare root Southern Red Cedar which they sell for \$218. per thousand.

The Division of Forestry--Andrews Nursery, Chiefland, FL, Phone 352-493-6096, currently has bare root Sand Pine at \$50. per thousand. Seeds have become scarce and they are not currently producing the containerized Sand Pine.

Southern Christmas Tree Plantation, (Bill Murray), Cordele, GA, (See advertisement) has Leland Cypress, Murray Cypress, and others in liners, in gallons and in three gallons. Phone 229-273-5748. The Murray Cypress seems to be the most disease resistant.

Aucker's Nursery, Williston, FL, (See Advertisement), phone 352-528-3889, has very nice Leland Cypress liners, and three to twenty-five gallon containerized. They have a very nice educational Web Site: www.auckersnursery.com

BK Cedars (Susan Kossuth), Alachua, FL Phone 386-462-2060 has a good supply of one gallon (\$3.) and three gallon(\$6.) genetically improved Southern Red Cedar ('Robin Blue') suitable for initial or replacement planting. She also has three gallon (\$7.) Carolina Sapphires. I get a few of these to sell to customers who are thinking of digging a small tree. It is easier than digging, and I plant what ever is left over. Michael




